## REACH 223 Substances Statement

Express Circuits Ltd has reviewed the operational requirements of REACH Regulations 1907/2006 and fully intends to support and comply with the regulations, where possible.

As a PCB supplier and downstream user of chemical substances in our manufacturing processes, we have a good understanding of the requirements of the REACH Directive.

We are confident that we do not knowingly export any articles that contain Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC's) that are on the latest Candidate List (SVHC 223 Candidate List, latest update 17.01.22) up to and including the date of this declaration with a concentration greater than 0.1% w/w. We maintain regular contact with our suppliers, to avoid the unintentional use of SVHC materials on the REACH Candidate List, as documented in the most recent update of Article 7(2), published in accordance with Article 59(10) of the REACH regulation, which can be accessed via the ECHA website, at: <https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>.

We undertake to keep ourselves and partners informed of the contents of Annex XIV of REACH and the Candidate List, as amended, and take the necessary steps to ensure where possible, that these substances are not included in the production of PCBs.

### DECLARATION

With the exception of product requiring Tin/ Lead finish at the request of our customers, none of the products produced by Express Circuits Ltd contain SVHC's on the latest Candidate List up to the date of this declaration in concentrations greater than 0.1% w/w. The declaration is made in good faith based on the information provided by manufacturers and suppliers to Express Circuits Ltd.
